<b>RESEARCH PROJECT</b>	<p>The research project which the candidates intend to carry out during their three years of PhD must meet the following requirements: 1) it must indicate a topic consistent with one of the curricula of the PhD (maximum 20.000 characters) and explicitly referring to it; 2) it must include: the state of the art; a description of the project; expected results; adequate bibliographical references.</p> <p>The research projects that successful applicants shall engage in during their doctoral career may possibly differ from the project proposed at the application stage: this shall be defined together with the supervisor and approved by the Academic Board.</p>
