<b>Practical-professional profile of the course and industry sector of reference</b>	This Master Course is dedicated to all scholars and professionals (from various disciplines) who wish to deepen and refine their educational and pedagogical skills in management, coordination, human resource management, design of educational proposals in clinical/training, and administrative responsibility. In particular, the technical activities proposed concern: The didactic activities of the master's program and the internship related to it are intended to support and develop the training of a specialized figure in pedagogical supervision. They are aimed at the social, clinical, educational, and teaching areas at school and after (academies, sports centers, cultural centers, etc.). At the end of the course, the trainee will have acquired specific knowledge of pedagogical and educational areas, with organizational, relational, and instrumental skills needed for managing education and training services. In addition, the trainee will gain knowledge and skills as a training planner and builder of national and international networks for creating links and continuity between various educational and school systems.
<b>Access prerequisites</b>	A bachelor's or master's degree or single-cycle degree awarded according to the system under Ministerial Decree No. 270/2004 or Ministerial Decree No. 509/1999 or previous systems.
