Practical-professional profile of the course and industry sector of reference	<p>The Master, inspired by the famous phrase of Socrates "A life not examined is not worth living", intends, in an innovative and original way, to put "Affective Education and Self-Care" at the center of the training path, providing all those precious and concrete tools for reading, knowledge and interpretation that come to us from the disciplinary fields that deal with them: Affective Education, Pedagogy, such as Paideia of the Soul, Philosophy, Psychoanalysis, Depth Psychology, Analytical Psychology and Archetypal Psychology.</p> <p>The objectives of the course therefore aim to develop the knowledge, skills, tools and attitudes essential for greater awareness and a life full of meaning and greater well-being, in harmony with the roots of Being.</p> <p>In particular, the course intends to train the figure of the Consultant of emotional relationships and self-care who will be able to operate between private individuals, bodies, associations, educational institutions and socio-health structures.</p> <p>To this end, the training activities will be divided into specific courses in which the themes and methodologies functional to the development of the students' skills will be explored from a theoretical and practical point of view.</p> <p>At the end of the Master's the students will have acquired the knowledge, skills and tools relating to emotional education and self-care (subject of the Master's), the advanced bases for the preparation of the various professional figures of the knowledge and care of Self (educators, teachers, philosophical analysts, existential consultants, philosophical consultants, psychologists, psychotherapists, psychoanalysts, etc.).</p>
