Practical-professional profile of the course and industry sector of reference	The Master's program is dedicated exclusively to the staff of the Region of Tuscany. It aims to delve deeper into the issues of public management within the processes of innovation and digitization of public administration. In particular, starting with the indispensable elements for the definition of proper planning, programming, and control cycle, the Master course develops and identifies digital and innovative solutions for the transition to a more competent public administration that is close to the needs of its stakeholders. The course thus aims to train personnel capable of promoting within the public administration processes of innovation and digitization.

Examinations procedures and schedule	The assessment of educational activities consists of examinations with a grade expressed in thirtieths and possible mention of honors held at the end of each module or subject. There will be a <i>project work</i> in lieu of the internship, to be carried out according to the student's current and possibly perspective, role in the relevant organization. The purpose is to acquire the functional skills to achieve the training objectives of the Master's professional profile. The credits provided for the practical activity are awarded to the student upon certification by the Master's Coordinator that such activity has been duly completed.
